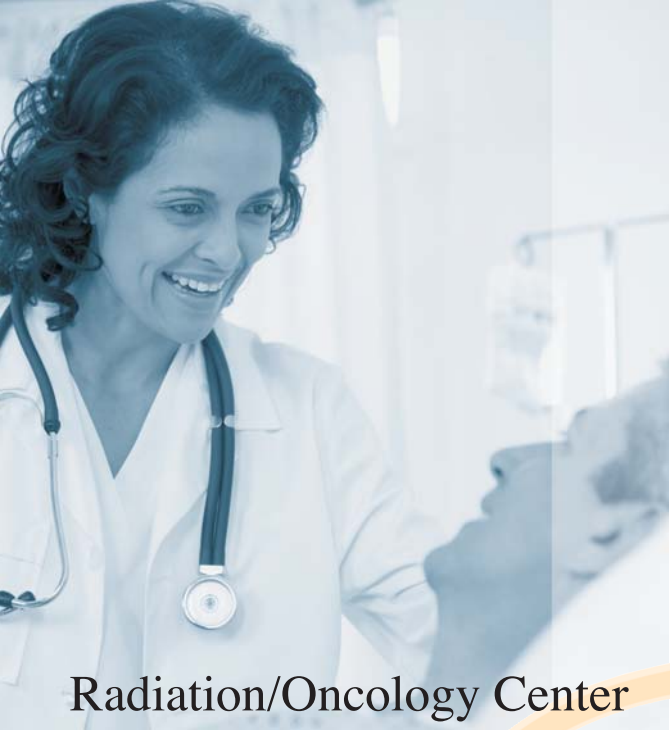

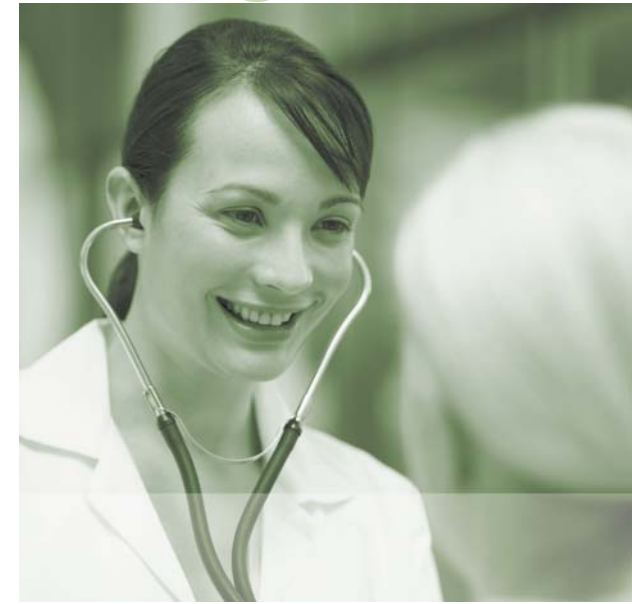
Some of the services provided include Intensity-Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT), stereotactic radiosurgery and high dose radiobrachytherapy.

Because cancer cells divide rapidly, they are highly sensitive to the effects of radiation. Since today's advanced technology allows physicians to tightly target the tumor, normal tissue is much less effected while tumors are destroyed. That results in better tumor control which leads to higher cancer cure rates.

The respected oncologists working at the Radiation/Oncology Center with trained oncology staff will know which drugs are the most effective for treating different forms of cancer at different stages. They know how to reduce or eliminate side effects from chemotherapy treatments.
