Notes:

1. *Percent outpatient may vary depending on rotation.
2. Continuity Clinic is a longitudinal experience occurring one half-day per week for 36 months.
3. Research occurs longitudinally for 36 months in addition to the three dedicated months on the block schedule.
4. Community Subspecialty Clinic – Outpatient clinical experience with program director who sees a large volume of complex conditions to ensure more pathology variety such as Inflammatory Bowel Disease patients and other complex cases that may not normally be seen in continuity clinic.
5. Core rotations include: Endoscopy Service, GI (Gastroenterology) Consult Service, Hepatology Service, Colorectal Surgery and Nutrition, Community Subspecialty Clinic; Research, and Continuity Clinic.
6. Individualized Educational Experiences include any of the core rotations plus pathology, radiology, and bariatrics; they are done in 15-day blocks in each year of training.
7. Colorectal Surgery and Nutrition rotation consists of 15 days in each area.
8. Vacation (15 days annually) will be taken during individualized educational experience (elective) and/or research time.
